INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of BANGALORE Chapter of Computer Society of India, which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31st March 2015, the Statement of Income and expenditure for the year then ended, and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

The Chapter's Management Committee is responsible with respect to the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position, financial performance of the Chapter in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the Accounting Standards as prescribed by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) This responsibility also includes the maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provision of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Chapter and for preventing and detecting the frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial control, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We have taken into account the provisions of the applicable and relevant Acts, the accounting and auditing standards and matters which are required to be included in the audit report under the provisions of the said Acts and the Rules made there under.

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing specified by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

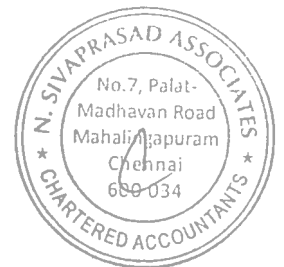
INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers Internal financial control relevant to the Chapter of the Society's preparation of the financial statements that give true and fair view in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on whether the chapter has in place an adequate internal financial controls system over financial reporting and the operating effectiveness of such controls. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by Management Committee, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion on the financial statements.

Basis for qualified opinion

We draw attention to Note No.16 regarding inclusion of National event in the normal chapter activities, which resulted in excess of income over expenditure amounting to Rs. 3,63,109/. The share of the HO in this amount is not quantified in the absence of details and the entire surplus from the program is taken as belonging to the chapter. If any share is payable it will go to reduce the surplus of the Chapter. In the absence of details regarding such share payable no provision could be made in the accounts and hence the effect of the same on the surplus of the year and also on the liabilities of the Chapter could not be quantified. Hence the quantitative effect of such non-provision on the chapter surplus and on the liabilities/ general fund could not be quantified.

Qualified Opinion

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion Paragraph, the aforesaid financial statements give the information required by the Act in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India; of the state of the chapter as at 31st March 2015, and its surplus for the year ended on that date.

- b) In our opinion proper books of account as required by law have been kept by the chapter so far as appears from our examination of those books.

- d) In our opinion, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the aforesaid financial statements comply with the Accounting Standards specified by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) to the extent mentioned in the notes forming part of the accounts.

NOTES ANNEXED TO AND FORMING PART OF ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH, 2015.

1. Financial statements have been prepared on historical cost basis as per normally accepted accounting principles and conventions.
2. Income and Expenditure has been recognized on accrual basis.
3. Assets are carried on the basis of closing written down value and no historical cost details exist.
4. Previous year's figures are re-grouped wherever necessary to facilitate comparison.
5. Depreciation has been provided according to the rates prescribed under Income tax Act 1961.
6. No provision for Audit fee has been made in the chapter accounts as the same is to be paid by the Head office.
- 7 Chapter share accrues to the Chapter only when Head office finalizes the same based on various criteria and passes on such payment. Chapter share received from Head office indicates years for which the amount is received separately in the communication. As the accrual to the Chapter arises when the payment authorization is communicated or when the cheque for such payment is made and sent to the chapter. Thus the same is accounted in such year in which the accrual takes place.
8. The Tax deducted at source represents balance brought down amounting to Rs.1,13,328.90 from previous years. During the year as a result of centralized accounts, accounting for TDS has been done by Head Quarters itself hence no TDS accounted in the books of accounts of the Chapter.
9. In the absence of any communication and in the absence of rules and regulations with regards to chapter share from the National events conducted by the chapter and in the absence of closure of such programs' accounts as at the financial year end of the Chapter no provision for such share could be made in the accounts of the Chapter. The provision could not be made as the amount receivable is either quantified or arrived at. Only when the program accounts are closed and sent to Head office and when HO quantifies the amount the same accrues to the chapter. This year no such accrual has taken place in favor of the

Chapter as the Head Officer has not authorized or quantified the same. As such no share from such events is accounted or provided for in this year.

10. The amount of TDS made by the chapter is sent to Head Office as the payments are to be made by the Head Office. It is not known to the Chapter whether such payments, for the monies remitted to HO, are made by the Head Office within due dates are not.

11. In the absence of opening balances from very long period the Chapter is not able to maintain fixed assets register as required by the Head Office accounting manual. In any case physical verification of the fixed assets is being done once in every year and if any discrepancies are found they are appropriately dealt with in the accounts. This year no such discrepancies were found and the management of the Chapter has not found any impairment in the value of such assets over the stated value.

12. Provision for employee benefits are done at Head Office level and the Chapter does not make any such provision in its books of accounts as per the guidelines of the Head Office.

13. The following programs have been conducted by the Chapter during the year for which the Chapter has neither collected registration fee nor any sponsorship fee.

14. Service tax to be collected and paid on taxable services is dealt with Head Quarters and hence no provision for liability for service tax, interest, penalty pertaining to the chapter is either made or provided in the accounts of the chapter. The service tax collected on behalf of Head office amounting to Rs. 52,740/- is shown as Service tax payable to HQ.

15. The amount charges in administrative expense amounting to Rs. 62,799/- represents the reduction in interest already accounted in previous years due to foreclosure of fixed deposits with Vijaya bank as per the instruction of Head office. An amount of Rs.10,000/- being cheque issued in previous year and taken expenses reversed as the cheque was not en-cashed and has become stale.

16. During the year National event of NCCSS 2015 was conducted by the chapter and no separate books of account and bank account as required by the HO guidelines has been maintained for this program. All the income and expenditure pertaining to this program is accounted in the chapter activities and no share has been given or provided to HQ. The surplus from this program is Rs. 3, 63,109/- and the entire surplus is taken as the income of the chapter. In case any share out of this is to be paid to HO then to that extent the surplus of the chapter becomes excessive and to that extent it should be taken that the profit of the year overstated. In the absence of the figure pertaining to the share to be given no provision is made in the accounts for such payment and hence the excess of income due to such non- Provision could not be quantified in the accounts. The effect of the same on the balance sheet of this year also could not be quantifies.
